

Access Statement

The school recognises that many of its pupils, visitors and staff, whether disabled or otherwise, have individual needs when using school and facilities. However, we also recognise that for some, the nature of their disabilities may mean that they experience specific difficulties related to accessing the physical environment. As part of the on-going commitment to the delivery of an inclusive educational service, we will endeavour to ensure that disabled pupils receive the same standards of education as pupils without disability.

To facilitate access:

- There is a dedicated disabled parking space within the school car park, situated at the nearest point to the main entrance.
- Our school building is all on one level.
- There are ramps to ensure access to the building.
- The main corridors are wide to provide ample space for free movement throughout the building, including wheelchairs.
- There is a toilet provided for use by those in a wheelchair.

In order to ensure that the educational services we provide effectively meet the needs of disabled pupils the school will:

- Consult with disabled pupils, parents and staff.
- Regularly review whether its education (and other) services are both accessible and effective, and take appropriate action.
- Welcome comments and suggestions from disabled people in order to make improvements.
