

**Pupil Premium Gap Busters:
Identifying the Levers for Improvements**



1. Data tracking that identifies the gaps

– data tracking is used rigorously across the whole school and identifies all underachieving pupils

2. High profile of pupils eligible for free school meals

– the high profile of disadvantaged pupils among staff, pupils, and parents and carers ensures that all are aware of their needs and of the support that is available

3. Effective teaching and learning

– all staff recognise and accept that the vast majority of pupils' progress comes out of good teaching and learning on a day-to-day basis

4. Literacy support

– the development of good literacy skills is a whole school focus. Standardised scores are collected for every pupil in every year for reading and spelling. These are carefully tracked and monitored across the school.

5. Targeted support

– tailored individual support is provided across the curriculum and arrangements are made for resources to be available for each pupil as needed

6. The full range of educational experiences

- support is given to ensure that all pupils have full access to broad educational experience

7. Good attendance

– staff, teachers, parents, carers and pupils understand the causal link between attendance and achievement. Attendance levels for all disadvantaged pupils are checked and acted upon. Systems are in place to make early identification of issue and need.
