

## Maths

In Maths we will be learning about:

- adding and subtracting
- counting across 10s and 100
- finding fractions
- missing number problems
- place value
- money and change
- measurement—weight and capacity
- creating block graphs

**Vocabulary:** add, subtract, coin, value, place value, measure, weight, capacity, litres, millilitres, grams, doubling, halving

## Science

In science we will be learning about the senses.

**Skills:**

- Identifying and labelling parts of the body
- How we use our senses
- Exploring the senses in a variety of ways

**Vocabulary:**

body parts, listening, speaking, smelling, touching, tasting, ears, nose, mouth, skin, taste buds, sweet, sour, loud, quiet, noisy, pitch, rough, smooth, soft, hard

## English

In English we will be learning about minibeasts to help us structure and write different types of stories.

**We will:**

- structure a story to include a beginning, middle and end
- write a sequence of sentences
- write an alternative ending to a story
- answer questions on a text
- sharing and writing our own fantasy story
- reading and writing our own mini-beast poem

**Vocabulary:**



- creating silhouettes


