Priority 1 – Outcomes

To ensure that KS2 SATs are above National

	Expected	Higher
Reading	76%	30%
Writing	84%	20%
Maths	76%	25%
Combined	72%	15%

- Progress scores to be positive and 75% of pupils to make better than expected progress

Priority 2 – Personal Development, Behaviour and Wellbeing

To improve the outcomes for Pupil Premium

- All PP pupils will make good or better progress from their starting points at the beginning of year 5
- More able PP pupils will make better than expected progress and their attainment will be higher than expected
- The in-school PP gap will close during their 4 years at Westley and PP will compare favourably with any national data available
- KS2 SATs results for PP will reach or exceed targets below:

Maths	57%	15%

Priority 3 – Teaching, Learning and Assessment

To improve the way in which teachers use assessment to improve pupil outcomes

- Teachers are using formative assessment and the marking and feedback within lessons is enabling pupils to move on
- Heads of Department are using the Trust Assessment System to identify gaps in learning and to inform CPD for staff
- All staff are confident in using the marking and feedback system and this is impacting on pupil progress

Priority 4 – Leadership and Management

To improve attendance for Disadvantaged pupils and decrease the number of pupils with persistent absence

- Disadvantaged pupils to achieve better than 96% attendance
- No disadvantaged pupil to be below 90% attendance
- No pupil to be below 80% attendance
- Reduce the number of pupils with less than 90% attendance
