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# OFSTED verdict: we're still "OUTSTANDING"

We were delighted to receive a letter from Ofsted this week confirming the outcome of its interim assessment of our school. As you may know, Ofsted now decides whether or not it needs to inspect schools which have previously been judged to be outstanding. It does this by looking at various aspects, including students' academic performance, students' attendance and any visits carried out by Ofsted since the last full inspection. We had a science inspection by Her Majesty's Chief Inspector who judged us outstanding in all areas. The outcome of the interim assessment is that Ofsted still judges us to be outstanding. We will therefore retain this status at least until it reviews us in a year's time. The letter can be found on our website. Congratulations to all our staff, students, parents, governors and community supporters on what is now our sixth Ofsted outstanding judgement.
