A few reminders

As the cold, dark weather approaches, a few reminders:

- Parents and other visitors should not park in the **turning circle** between 8.30 and 9.00 am and 3.35 and 4.10 pm. We have also been asked to remind parents that they should not use the car park for 'The Greengage' public house.
